1 Introduction

Based on the Regulation of the Minister of Education and Culture of the Republic of Indonesia Number 111 of 2014, it is stated that the guidance and counseling service process aims to help achieve a maximum, independent and complete counseling process which includes personal, learning, social and career aspects. Some strategies used by counselors are identifying student needs by carrying out needs assessments. Student needs-based assessments provide benefits to several professional counselors and counseling organizations. This can help counselors identify potential gaps in services and help improve their services so that all categories of groups can be served. The results of assessments based on student needs can be integrated into the broader counseling program evaluation process, thereby strengthening the quality of services offered to clients [2]. Service activities in guidance and counseling carried out based on the results of needs analysis can be realized in the form of more innovative programs. The indicators for needs analysis include the process of collecting, interpreting and synthesizing information so that it can be used as a reference in making decisions. Preparing programs for guidance and counseling activities is a managerial step, so that the objectives can be measured in terms of quality

Achieving quality results will be if managed through a quality process, so that the Guidance and Counseling program is prepared by paying attention to management steps such as assessment, planning, organizing, implementing core and supporting services, and evaluation. [5] There are several instruments that are commonly used by Guidance and Counseling teachers and students in conducting needs assessments, including: the general Problem Uncovering Tool and the AUM PTSDL which were developed by Prayitno, et al in Komalasari [8], the Problem Checklist (DCM), Developmental Tasks Inventory and sociometry. There is a similarity between several of the instruments mentioned above, namely the type of instrument that is Paper Based Test. Ifdil, et al [6] updated the General AUM and PTSDL AUM by developing a computer-based data processing application program. The results of their research also found that processing with computer-based programs was more efficient than manual processing. However, there are several obstacles found in the field, namely: the distribution of applications is still relatively uneven, and there are also limitations in the number of computers that can install the application, so that currently there are still many guidance and counseling teachers and especially students who carry out data processing manually.

Manual data processing has several weaknesses, including: it is susceptible to human error, takes a long time, thus hampering the preparation of guidance and counseling programs. In the field, problems were also found due to difficulties in carrying out Need Assessments manually, resulting in guidance and counseling students not preparing programs or planning guidance and counseling services according to course bills. This of course has a negative impact on the quality of the services they provide because it is not in accordance with the clients' needs and conditions [10].

According to Istirahayu [7] Assessment is an effort to find out the abilities possessed, the obstacles or difficulties experienced, to find out the background to why the obstacles or difficulties arise and to find out what assistance is needed by the person concerned. Based on the data from the assessment results, an appropriate learning program for the child can be created. Need Assessment is the counselor's main and first job in creating a Guidance and Counseling Program. So, Need Assessment is the main key in the development of the next Guidance and Counseling Program. In implementing a counseling strategy, Need Assessment plays an important role in implementing the next strategy. According to Putro [13] the general stages in the counseling process include: Relationship Building (Rapport), Problem Assessment, Goal Formulation, Goal Selection, Strategy Selection, Strategy Implementation, Evaluation and Follow-up and finally Termination. It is clear as explained above that the assessment stage is a very important stage before determining goals in the counseling process.

According to Putri [12] the instrumentation application is a basic indicator for determining the type of service in the implementation of counseling guidance. According to Thorin in Muskarno [9] The aim of applying instrumentation in general is to obtain data about certain conditions of clients (students) such as basic potential, talents and interests, personal and environmental conditions and problems experienced. And the implementation of instrumentation application activities in collecting data about client (student) needs and problems can be carried out using various test and non-test instruments [11]. The urgency of need assessment in Guidance and Counseling, the need for an application that can make it easier for Guidance and Counseling students to carry out needs assessments and the unavailability of such facilities in the Guidance and Counseling laboratory has encouraged researchers to design a need assessment application in the Guidance and Counseling

laboratory so that it can be a means for students to assess needs. clients in preparing Guidance and Counseling programs both for course requirements and for School Field Experience activities [1].

2 Research Method

This research uses the Research and Development method which aims to produce certain products, and test the effectiveness of the products developed). Borg and Gall [3] define research development (R&D) as the process used to produce and validate a product being developed. There are several stages used, including gradually studying research findings on the product being developed, then entering the product design development stage, and carrying out field testing and making revisions based on the results of implementation in the field. By implementing a structured development pattern, this cycle will be repeated so that field test data will show that the product is suitable for long-term use. The research and development that will be carried out is to produce a website-based Need Assessment Instrumentation Application in the Counseling Guidance Laboratory of the Faculty of Education.

The following are the development stages in this research:

- a. The definition stage aims to: Front-end Analysis, Learner Analysis, Task Analysis and Concept Analysis.
- b. The design stage is the application is designed on a website with the following component menu:
 - 1. Login, this menu is used to log in as admin or participant.
 - 2. Home, contains a menu of four areas of Guidance and Counseling development, namely: Personal, Social, Career and Learning.
 - 3. The sub menu for the four Guidance and Counseling Development areas will contain several non-test instruments that will measure the client's conditions and needs in each area.
 - 4. The last sub menu is an analysis of the process of instrument results that have been filled in by students/clients.
- c. The development stage:
 - 1. Validation, namely testing the validity of the media and content in the application developed in this research, is carried out by experts in the field whose validity will be measured.
 - 2. Limited trials were carried out on 30 Guidance and Counseling students as research samples to determine the feasibility of the application being developed.
- d. The product dissemination stage is carried out to disseminate the product being developed so that it can be accepted by the public. To produce an appropriate product, you must use packaging that is flexible and easy for people to use.

3 Results and Discussion3.1 Definition3.1.1 Learning Application Needs Analysis

In the initial research stage, researchers collected data through interviews with several students. Refer on the results of the interview, researchers obtained information that students need a validated needs assessment application to facilitate the completion of course assignments and as a reference and tool in implementing the Introduction to Schooling Field program. Based on initial research conducted through interviews with Guidance and Counseling Faculty of Education students, it can be concluded that there needs to be an application consisting of various instruments in the four fields of guidance and counseling which can help students carry out needs assessments to analyze client needs so that students can develop proper Guidance and Counseling programs such as Instrument Needs Assessment application as well as a tool to help carry out implementing the Introduction to Schooling Field program. Based on this description, researchers conducted a literature study to study instruments that have been developed by experts in learning and career guidance and counseling, social fields and personal abilities.

3.2 Design3.2.1 Preparation of Website Content and Materials

At this stage the researcher prepares the content and instrument application material needed as an assessment. The instruments used are test and non-test instruments, such as AUM and Questionnaires. The available instruments refer to the needs of four areas of guidance and counseling services.

- a. Personal Area Instruments: Self-Concept, Self-Control, Self-Efficacy, Empathy, Self-Esteem, Self-Understanding, Self-confidence, Self-adjustment, Effective communication, Low self-esteem, etc.
- b. Social Sector Instruments: Consumer behavior, parenting patterns, attachment, social sensitivity, social relationships, social behavior, social emotions, aggressive behavior, bullying, relationships with peers, etc.
- c. Learning Field Instruments: Learning difficulties, learning concentration, learning boredom, learning behavior, learning facilities, learning time management, learning styles, academic stress, procastination, learning motivation, learning difficulties, etc.
- d. Career Field Instruments: Career maturity, career planning, career expectations, career choice tendencies, etc.

3.2.2 Design of Web-based Applications

After designing the content and contents of the Need Assessment application, proceed with creating a website-based application.




Fig. 1. Home View of the Application




Fig. 2. Menu Display Contents of the Need Assessment Instrument Application
