While Belitung had the least with 4,690.10, the Bangka Regency Agriculture and Food Service reported that the area's output volume of fresh fruit bunches (FFB) reached 4,050 tons per day. Based on factory capacity statistics when it is operational, the FFB production capacity of oil palm collected by farmers is 4,050 tons per day. The area's productive oil palm plantations are estimated to cover roughly 39,000 hectares for plantations owned by firms or managed by individuals [4]

The Bangka Belitung Islands Province's Regional Revenue from regional original revenue (PAD) realization in 2021 has increased significantly, even exceeding the objective. The realization of the Babel Province Regional Original Revenue in 2021 is the largest realization this year or since the province's inception.

In the first quarter of 2021, the share of realized regional original revenue (PAD) that shows regional fiscal independence is 31.28% of total regional income, an increase over the first quarter of 2020, when it was 24.12% of total revenue. This suggests that regional fiscal independence will grow in the first quarter of 2021. PAD realization in the first quarter of 2021 is IDR 145.46 billion, or 19.41% of the 2021 objective, which is greater than the previous year's realization of 15.87% or Rp. 118.74 billion. The increase in nominal PAD realization in the first quarter of 2021 was attributed to a Rp. 134.81 billion increase in realized regional tax income [5]

The growth in regional original revenue for the Province of Bangka Belitung in 2021 is due to economic improvement in Babel, which has resulted in greater payment of regional taxes and levies, as well as contributions from industry and oil palm farms. Regional original revenue from the cultivation of oil palm plants will fall in 2021. The weather component with relatively heavy rainfall is thought to be the key factor reducing plantation commodity yield, where fertilization activities and fertilizer absorption are not optimal. Furthermore, according to the cyclical pattern, the productivity of plantation crops decreases at the start of each year following the end of the primary harvest at the end of the year.
